

## *Golf Introduction*

### **What is the aim or the goal of Golf game?**

The goal in golf game is to put the ball into the hole, which is under the flag at end of each playground(hole).

The winner at golf game is the one who makes the fewest shots for the whole golf course (18 holes).

### **What are the benefits or the advantages of the golf game?**

- Golf is a beautiful game, which helps you to clear your mind, you forget everything and you have only one problem which is to put your ball into the hole.
- Golf helps you to develop your thinking skills, because you will find your ball in different positions and you have to play the ball as it lies.

- In Golf you can play individual or with groups your family, friends, your partners, etc.
- Golf helps you to meet new people that's why Business men love golf to meet new people and making deals. In Golf you are walking for long distance without feeling tired which is very healthy, the full golf course is round 7 km more, or less.
- In the golf course you are Enjoying the atmosphere, nature, trees, flowers, and landscapes.
- In the golf course you are enjoying, playing, and breathing fresh air.

# What does the Golf course contain?

The full Golf course contains of 18 different playgrounds, in golf we call the one playground a Hole, so hole #1 means playground #1 etc.



Each hole or each playground contains the following things: -

## The Tee box



**Tee box is the start point for each hole where you have to start. It has 2 tee box marks, where you have to stand between them. There is a tee box for Professional players which is the farthest one to the hole. There is a tee box for men and another one for ladies and another one for kids which is the nearest one to the hole.**

# The Green




**The Golf Green is the whole soft grass area round the hole.**

## The Fairway



**The whole grass area between The Tee Box and the Green, we call it the “Fairway”**

# The Rough



**The high rough grass by the sides of the Fairway**

## The Landscape

The general nature of the Golf course like trees, flowers, grass, sand, water, and some time rocks.


The landscapes are different from a hole to another hole, and from a Golf course to another Golf course.

Some big holes full of soft sand inside the Golf course.


# The Plenty Area



An area defined by the club as plenty area it could be water area as sea, lake, river, or small canals or it could be woods or any area defined by the club.

## The Hole

At the end of each playground there is a hole under the flag, which we are looking to put our ball into it, it's about 4,25 inches.



# The Flag



**Above each hole there is a flag, the flag is to help players to know the right way to the hole from far distance.**

# Distance marks, or Distance posts




To help you to know how far you are from the hole.

## **Yellow marks, or Yellow posts or Yellow line**




**To help you to know the bounds of

To help you to know the bounds of the golf course.

## The Divot



**When you hit the ball some grass fly away this flying grasses we call it divot , and you have to bring your divot back to its place after playing the ball.**

# The Golf clubs



The golf sticks/rackets we call it golf clubs, there are 14 different Golf Clubs. The golf clubs have different angles to make different distances.

# The Golf Set



**a group of golf clubs we call it “golf set”**

# Iron Clubs



**These sort of clubs are called Irons because it has an iron head and they are in numbers from 9 till 3, If the club number go smaller the angle go closer which make the ball go longer. The ball distance is different from person to another because we are different in bodies and muscles.**

## Wood clubs



These sorts of clubs are called wood to hit for longer distances  
it called wood clubs because in the past  
it was made of wood  
They are 3 kinds, there is 5 wood which  
is for long distance, then there is  
Wood 3 which is longer,  
Then wood 1 / or it's called the Driver,  
which is the longest club.



# Hybrid/ Risqué



**It is new club. It is something between Iron clubs and Wood clubs. We can use it instead of 3&4Iron**

**Short clubs**

**Wedge / W Club   Sandwedge / S Club  
Lope wedge / L Club**

**All these clubs are for playing short distance, they have very open angle.**

**W Club** is for playing short distance we call it pitching game



**S&L Clubs** for playing shorter distances we call it chipping and for playing on sand too.



# Putter Club



We use this club when we are playing on the green to put the ball into the hole.

## The Tee



**Tee is a plastic or wooden piece  
it's allowed to use the tee only on the  
Tee box at the beginning of each hole.**

# The Golf Ball



**Especial ball for golf, it's about 45,93 grams and about 1,62 inches. it can be in different colors.**

# The Ball Marker



We are using the ball marker to mark the ball place if we need to move the ball.

# The Golf Trolley



It's to carry the golf bag.

# The Golf Car




**It is allowed to drive with a golf cart,

grass of green because of the ball drops.**


# The Grip

# The Glove




We use a glove to have a strong grip. If you are right-handed, you will use a glove for your left hand, but if you are left-handed, you will use a glove for your right hand.

It is a card to write your score in the game and it has some information about the Golf course.


## The Golf Rules

# Golf Swing



**The whole movement or the whole circle which you do when you hit the ball with your clubs, we call this movement the Golf Swing.**

## **The Golf Handicap**

**Your Handicap is your level in the game and it is the difference between your score, and the professional rate of the Golf course which is 72 points.**

**Low number means that you are playing better.**

## **The Driving Range**



**It's a place to practice or to warm up or to learn golf.**

## **Long Game**

when you want to play the ball for long distance.

## **Short Game**

when you want to play the ball for middle distance.

## **Pitching**

when you want to play the ball for short distance.

## **Chipping**

when you want to play the ball while you are round the Green.

## **Putting**

when you want to play the ball while you are on the green.

## **Bunker Shot**

when you want to play the ball while you are in the bunker.

# **Safety**

**The most important thing is Safety.**

**So, before using the Golf clubs to play Golf make sure that,**

**No one near to you or in front of you to avoid hitting someone with your club or with your ball.**
